

Bosch extends official sponsorship of SUPER GT until 2030

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Contributing to the development of motorsports through one of the largest automobile races in Japan

- ▶ Sponsorship agreement to be renewed for five years from 2026 to 2030
- ▶ Bosch components will continue to be supplied to all GT500 Class cars
- ▶ Continuing its commitment to Japan through a total of 11 years of sponsorship agreement since 2020

Yokohama (Japan) — Bosch, a leading global supplier of technology and services, has signed an agreement with GTA Co., Ltd. (President, CEO: Masaaki Bandoh, hereinafter "GTA") to continue its sponsorship as a "Series Partner" of the SUPER GT, one of the largest automobile races in Japan. The contract period is for five years, starting from 2026 to 2030.

Bosch has been a "Series Partner," an official sponsor of SUPER GT, since 2020. With the contract renewal, Bosch will support the race for a total of 11 years from 2020 to 2030. Bosch will continue to supply common components for all cars of the GT500 Class of the SUPER GT series. In addition, the Bosch logo will be visible on all GT500 Class cars, among others.

Christian Mecker, president and representative director of Bosch Corporation commented on the renewal of the contract, "We are greatly honored to continue as an official sponsor of SUPER GT. Bosch's long-standing technical support for SUPER GT, the premier motorsport series in Japan, demonstrates our commitment to Japan. Bosch will continue to contribute to the development of technology and safety in motorsports in Japan."

[Outline of Partnership Agreement]

Period: Five years from 2026 to 2030

Details: 1. Supply of common components to GT500 cars
Multi-display, engine control unit, power box, injector, high-pressure

pump, wiper motor, various sensors, etc.

2. Bosch logo exposure

All GT500 Class cars of the SUPER GT series, safety cars and First Rescue Operation cars, programs and posters, podium backboards, etc.

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Bosch in Japan is currently represented in the country by Bosch Corporation, Bosch Rexroth Corporation, Bosch Home Comfort Japan, Inc., and other affiliates. Bosch Corporation is responsible for the development, manufacturing, sales and services of automotive original equipment, automotive aftermarket products and power tools. Bosch Engineering K.K. provides engineering services, such as development and application for automotive systems. ETAS K.K. develops and provides engineering of development support tools of electrical control units. Bosch Rexroth Corporation develops and manufactures hydraulics, FA module components and other systems which contribute to industrial technologies. Bosch Home Comfort Japan, Inc. develops and manufactures Hitachi room air conditioners "Shirokumakun." In 2024, Bosch Japan achieved sales to third parties of some 428 billion yen and employed approximately 6,300 associates.

The Bosch Group is a leading global supplier of technology and services. It employs roughly 412,000 associates worldwide (as of December 31, 2025). According to preliminary figures, the company generated sales of 91 billion euros in 2025. Its operations are divided into four business sectors: Mobility, Industrial Technology, Consumer Goods, and Energy and Building Technology.
